REFORE THE STATE ENGINEER OF THE STATE OF OREGON KLAMATH COUNTY

In the Matter of Application

Number 6419 of the California

Oregon Power Company, for Permit to Appropriate Water from

Link River, Klamath County, Oregon.

ORDER

Now at this time this matter coming on for further consideration, and it appearing that the water sought to be appropriated by said application and permit is water stored in Upper Klamath Lake by means of the storage dam constructed across the outlet thereof.

And it further appearing that all of the water of Upper Klamath Lake and Link River, together with the water of other streams in Klamath County, tributary to Klamath River, has been filed upon by the United States pursuant to the provisions of Section 5791, Oregon Laws, and that such water is not subject to appropriation at this time.

And it appearing that the Attorney-General has rendered an opinion advising that the State Engineer was not authorized to approve the application of the California Oregon Power Company for permit to appropriate water as shown in said application and the map accompanying the same, and as legal adviser of the State Engineer, the Attorney-General recommends the cancellation of said permit, and the State Engineer being now fully advised in the premises,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the approval of said application is hereby rescinded and revoked, and that said permit be and the same is hereby cancelled and held for naught and of no further force or effect, in order to clear the records of the State Engineer's Office.
