Kenneth G. Harlan has displayed sufficient good faith and evidence of his intention to utilize the water proposed to be appropriated, if the project is found to be feasible, NOW, THEREFORE;

It is hereby OHDERED that said applications be approved and permits issued thereon, provided satisfactory maps and other data are filed in connection with said applications within sixty days or such further time as may be granted for good cause.
