## ORDER

Now, at this time, the above entitled matter coming on for consideration before the State Engineer on the application of Albert C. Armstrong for the approval of a change in place of use of water under the Arnold Irrigation Company's canal, and it appearing that by decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County dated February 10, 1928, an inchoate water right was recognized in the name of the Arnold Irrigation Company for the irrigation of 9,392 acres, of which the following are involved in this transfer:

39 acres in the SW2SW2, Section 14; 37 acres in the SE2 SE2, Sc. cion 15, 38 acres in the NW2WW1, Section 23, All Township 18 South, Range 12 East, W. M.

That the applicant herein proposes to transfer 5 acres from the SWLSKL Section 14, 3 acres from the SELSE Section 15, and 2 acres from the NWLNWL Section 23, to a 10-acre tract in the NELSE Section 33, Twp. 17 South, Range 12 E. W. M.. It appears that no existing rights would be affected by the approval of the transfer and that all lands involved herein are under the Arnold Irrigation Company's system, which company has submitted its approval in writing to the transfer;

NOW THEREFORE, it is ORDERLD that the change in place of use of water be and the same hereby is approved without loss of the priority of the rights heretofore established, provided that such water to be transferred shall be applied to the NE-SE; of Section 33, Twp. 17 South, Range 12 East, W. M., within one year from the date of this order, or such period of time as may be extended by the State Engineer for good cause shown.
