On May 12, 1988, Orvin V. and Adeline O. Rollefson submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant, that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 26128, Volume 18, State Record of Water Certificates, in the name of Arnold Sandwick, Trustee. It is for the use of not to exceed 0.003 cubic foot per second of water from the Deschutes River, with a date of priority of September 30, 1952, for the irrigation of 0.13 acre. The place of use is in SW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 31, Township 16 South, Range 12 East, WM, being more explicitly described as Lots 14 and 15, Block 25 of the plat of Tumalo.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 26128, Volume 18, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
