
On July 15, 1970, Owen G. Froerer submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a water right and the lands to which the right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same to be canceled.

The water right in question is for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.06 cubic foot per second of water from waste water in Cow Hollow Wasteway with a priority date of March 14, 1955, for the supplemental irrigation of 30.0 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, Township 19 South, Range 47 East, W.M., and is a part of that evidenced by the certificate issued in the name of The Owyhee Ditch Company and recorded at Page 29394, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the State Engineer that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the State Engineer shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the right for the use of 0.06 cubic foot per second of water from Cow Hollow Wasteway for the supplemental irrigation of 30.0 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 29, Township 19 South, Range 47 East, W.M. with a date of priority of March 14, 1955, as evidenced by the certificate recorded at Page 29394, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
