On May 18, 1987, Henri Van Tricht submitted an affidavit that he is the Chairman of the Congregation for Tigard Christian Church, and that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant, that the Church has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 14675, Volume 12, State Record of Water Certificates, in the names of Arthur R. and Violet I. Prier. It is for the use of not to exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second of water from Fanno Creek, with a date of priority of January 18, 1940, for the irrigation of 3.5 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Graham DLC 39, Section 2, Township 2 South, Range 1 West, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 14675, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
