IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF HAROLD BJORG FOR THE APPROVAL OF A CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION OF WATER FROM MILL CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF BIG CREEK.

ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION

On October 8, 1937, Harold Bjorg, of Knappa, Oregon, filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from Mill Creek, a tributary of Big Creek.

Certificate of Water Right No. 7409 was issued to Harold Bjorg confirming an appropriation under Permit No. 7003 for domestic use within the NW: NW: Of Section 17, Township 8 North, Range 7 West, W. M., with date of priority of July 8, 1924, the point of diversion being located 300 feet North and 1425 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 29, Township 8 North, Range 7 West, W. M.

The applicant herein proposes to change the present point of diversion to a point to be located 1530 feet South and 1445 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 32, Township 8 North, Range 7 West, W. M.

Notice of filing application for such change in point of diversion was published in the Evening Astorian-Budget, a newspaper printed and having general circulation in Clatsop County, for four successive and consecutive weeks in the issues of November 11, 18, 25 and December 2, 1937, as provided by Section 47-712, Oregon Code 1930.

No objections having been filed, it appears that the proposed change in point of diversion may be made without injury to existing rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in point of diversion, to-wit: from a point located 300 feet North and 1425 feet East from the Southwest corner of Section 29, Township 8 North, Range 7 West, W. M., to a point to be located 1530 feet South and 1445 feet East from the Northwest corner of Section 32, Township 8 North, Range 7 West, W. M., for domestic use within the NW NW of Section 17, Township 8 North, Range 7 West, W. M., with date of priority of July 8, 1924, be and the same hereby is approved.
