Under certain orders of the State Engineer heretofore entered approving changes in place of use of water of the above-named parties, the time limits were fixed to apply water to beneficial use as provided by Section 116-606, O. C. L. A.

The statements contained in the applications for extensions of time indicate that each applicant has shown such reasonable diligence as entitles him to an extension of time.

No protests or objections to the granting of extensions of time have been filed.
