

## HOOD RIVER COUNTY.

O R D E R

Now at this time this matter coming on for consideration before the State Engineer on the application of the Middle Fork Irrigation District, and it appearing that by decree of the Circuit Court for Hood River County dated October 24, 1921, an inchoate right was recognized in the name of the Middle Fork Irrigation District for 3,000 inches of water with a priority of November 19, 1906;

That the present point of diversion is on the right bank of Middle Fork of Middle Fork of Hood River in the Southwest quarter of Section 34, Township 1 South, Range 9 East, W.M.;

That the applicant now proposes to change the point of diversion for 250 miner's inches of said water at a point six miles lower down and on the Middle Fork of Hood River, which bears <sup>S.</sup> 65° East of the <sup>75'</sup> Southwest corner of Section 31, Township 1 North, Range 10 East W.M.;

And that it further appears that a notice of the filing of such application has been given by the State Engineer by publication in The Hood River News, a newspaper of general circulation in Hood River County, for three successive and consecutive weeks and that no objection to such application has been filed, and it further appearing that such change in point of diversion will be of advantage to the applicant and that no other right will be injured by such change,

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that said change in point of diversion be and the same is hereby approved.
