Findings of Fact

1. The Water Resources Department issued an order approving Transfer Application T-10765 in the name of North Unit Irrigation District on February 17, 2009. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 77, at Page 250. The order set a transfer completion date of October 1, 2010.
2. On October 1, 2010, the Department received an application for extension of time for transfer of water right T-10765 from North Unit Irrigation District.
3. The applicant has completed all changes authorized in the final order with the exception of the James and Debra Marshall property.
4. To fully complete the change, it will be necessary for the applicant to seed the area. The landowner has not been able to complete the change in place of use due to the economy and costs associated with the transfer.
5. The applicant has requested that the time for completion of beneficial use be extended to October 1, 2011.

Conclusions of Law


Pursuant to OAR 690-380-6020, the Director of the Water Resources Department concludes the applicant has shown reasonable diligence to complete the transfer within the time period established by the order approving Transfer Application T-10765.

This is a final order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60 day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080 you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The time for completion of beneficial use authorized by T-10765 shall be extended to October 1, 2011.
