**AUTHORITY**

ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to temporarily transfer the place of use and, if necessary to convey the water to the temporary place of use, the point of diversion or appropriation authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.



On September 17, 2004, Willamette Valley Vineyards, Inc. filed an application to temporarily transfer the place of use under Certificates 21970, 21971 and 22015. The Department assigned the application number T-9787.

Notice of the application for temporary transfer was published pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.

On April 12, 2005, Willamette Valley Vineyards, Inc. submitted a written request to withdraw transfer application T-9787. In addition, Willamette Valley Vineyards, Inc. requested that \$125.00 of fees be transferred to transfer application T-9786, which will be used for a Reimbursement Authority Estimate. Any remaining unearned fees will be refunded. Transfer Application T-9787, in the name of Willamette Valley Vineyards, Inc., is withdrawn and of no further force of effect.
