Findings of Fact

1. On September 17, 2020, the Department issued an order approving Transfer T-11721. The order was recorded at Special Order Volume 117, Pages 540-552. A new confirming instream water right certificate was also issued as evidenced by Certificate 95248.
2. The order contained scrivener errors in Findings of Fact No. 26 and No. 59 identifying the point of diversion location:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
13 S	9 E	WM	16	SW SW	POD 1: 20 FEET SOUTH AND 276 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 16

3. The correct location of the point of diversion is:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
13 S	9 E	WM	16	SW SW	POD 1: 20 FEET NORTH AND 276 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 16

4. The confirming right Certificate 95248 also identified the point of diversion incorrectly as shown above.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The order approving T-11721, as recorded in Special Order Volume 117, Pages 540-552 is corrected to identify the correct location of the point of diversion.
2. All other provisions of Special Order Volume 117, Pages 540-552 remain in effect.
3. Water right Certificate 95248 is cancelled.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

4. Water right Certificate 95492 is issued to supersede Certificate 95248 and to correctly describe the point of diversion.
