Authority

Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) 537.610, 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which the holder of a certificate of registration may submit a request for recognition of modifications to the place of use, character of use or point of appropriation under a groundwater certificate of registration.

Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) Chapter 690, Divisions 382 and 380 implement the statutes and provide the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating groundwater registration modification applications.

Applicant

C AND E BRENTANO FAMILY LP 5009 DAVIDSON ROAD NE SAINT PAUL, OR 97137

Findings of Fact

- On March 1, 2018, C AND E BRENTANO FAMILY LP, filed a groundwater registration modification application for additional points of appropriation, a change in point of appropriation and to modify the place of use under Registration Application GR-1377 (Certificate of Registration GR-1334). The Department assigned the application number T-12858.
- 2. On March 15, 2018, the agent for the applicant contacted the Department regarding an error in the application submitted to the Department.
- 3. On March 21, 2018, the agent for the applicant submitted amended application pages and maps addressing a mapping error.
- 4. On November 14, 1966, Registration Application GR-1377 (Certificate of Registration GR-1334) was assigned from T. M. VAN DYKE to EDWARD T. BRENTANO.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- On March 5, 2018, Registration Application GR-1377 (Certificate of Registration GR-1334)
 was partially assigned by proof of ownership from THEODORE M. VAN DYKE to C&E
 BRENTANO FAMILY LIMITED PARTNERSHIP.
- On March 27, 2018, Registration Application GR-1377 (Certificate of Registration GR-1334)
 was partially assigned from CAROL M. BRENTANO (authorized to sign for EDWARD T.
 BRENTANO, deceased) to RD FARMS INC.
- 7. Notice of the application for groundwater registration modification was published on March 6, 2018, pursuant to OAR 690-382-0600. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 8. On June 29, 2021, the Department sent a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Groundwater Registration Modification Application T-12858 to the applicant. The draft Preliminary Determination cover letter set forth a deadline of August 1, 2021, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the Groundwater Registration Modification.
- 9. On September 29, 2021, the Department issued a Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Groundwater Registration Modification T-12858 and mailed a copy to the applicant. Additionally, notice of the Preliminary Determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on October 5, 2021, and in the Woodburn Independent newspaper on October 6 and 13, 2021, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

Review Criteria for Groundwater Registration Modification Applications [OAR 690-382-0700(2)]

- 14. The proposed modifications would not result in enlargement of the groundwater registration.
- 15. The proposed modifications would not result in a state Scenic Waterway not receiving previously available water during periods in which streamflows are less than the quantities determined by the Department to be necessary to meet the requirements of ORS 390.835.

16. The proposed modifications would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The additional points of appropriation, change in point of appropriation and modification in place of use proposed in Groundwater Registration Modification T-12858 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.610, 537.705, 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-382-1000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- The modifications to Registration Application GR-1377 (Certificate of Registration GR-1334) proposed in Groundwater Registration Modification Application T-12858 are recognized. Recognition of the modifications shall not be construed as a final determination of the right to appropriate groundwater under the certificate of registration or modification. Such a determination will occur in an adjudication proceeding under ORS 537.670 to 537.695.
- The use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Registration Application GR-1377(Certificate of Registration GR-1334) and any related decree.
- 3. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.
- 4. The quantity of water diverted at the additional point of appropriation (APOA3), together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation (POA 4), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
- 5. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (POA 3, POA 4, and POA 5) together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation (POA 4), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
- 6. The former place of use of the modified groundwater registration shall no longer receive water as part of the groundwater certificate of registration.
