IN THE MATTER OF THE CANCELATION OF A WATER RIGHT IN THE NAME OF ELI W. HOWELJ,

ORDER

On March 5, 1974, Melvin E. and Iris R. Howell submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a water right and the lands to which the right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and request the same to be canceled.

The water right in question is for the use of not to exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second of the waters from Clear Creek for the irrigation of 3.25 acres in N₄ SW₂ NW₄, Section 17, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of September 27, 1935, and is evidenced coertificate of water right recorded at page 14377, Volume 12, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

That part of the water right evidenced by said certificate for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.08 cubic foot per second of the waters of Clear Creek for irrigation of 5.75 acres in SW4 NW4, Section 17, Township 1 North, Route 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of September 27, 1935, is not in question.

ORS 540.621 provides: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the State Engineer that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the State Engineer shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the right for the use of not to exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second of the waters of Clear Creek for the irrigation of 3.25 acres in N_4^1 SW $_4^1$ NW $_4^1$, Section 17, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of September 27, 1935, is canceled.
