On July 31, 1981, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Keith Cyrus for approval of a change in place of use of water from Squaw Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By Decree of the Circuit Court for Deschutes County, Oregon, entered May 1, 1911, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Squaw Creek and Its Tributaries, a water right was established in the name of Squaw Creek Irrigation Company, tabulated in Volume 1, page 125, Order Record of the Water Resources Director, for use of the waters of Squaw Creek for irrigation of, among other lands, a certain 40.0 acres in NE I/4 NW I/4 and 40.0 acres in NW I/4 NW I/4, Section 17, Township I4 South, Range I2 East, WM. Transfer D-7 changed the place of use of 43.0 acres to 23.0 acres in NW I/4 SE I/4 and 20.0 acres in SW I/4 SE I/4, Section 12, Township I5 South, Range I0 East, WM, with a date of priority of November II, 1895, as evidenced by the certificate recorded at page 302, Volume I, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to change the place of use of aforesaid 23.0 acres and 20.0 acres, without loss of priority, to 18.0 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 36, Township 14 South, Range 10 East, WM; 17.0 acres in SW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 31, Township 14 South, Range 11 East, WM; 4.0 acres in Lot 3 (NE 1/4 NW 1/4) and 4.0 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 6, Township 15 South, Range 11 East, WM.

A supplemental right under Permit 29312 is to be transferred with said primary right.

Robert F. Main, Jr., Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1983.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order and other transfer orders within Squaw Creek Irrigation District, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the said district.
