Authority

ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to transfer the point of appropriation, place of use, or character of use authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.

Findings of Fact

Background

- 1. On March 30, 2009, Jason Williams Hay Inc. filed an application for additional points of appropriation under Certificates 53299 and 74070. The Department assigned the application number T-10837.
- 2. The first right to be transferred is as follows:

Certificate: 53299 in the name of Gary L Kramer (perfected under Permit G-5385)

Use: SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 188.7 ACRES

Priority Date: APRIL 9, 1971

Rate: 2.22 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND

Limit/Duty: The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured

under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each

year.

- 6. Notice of the application for transfer was published on April 21, 2009, pursuant to OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 7. On August 19, 2009, the Department mailed to the applicant a copy of the draft Preliminary Determination proposing to approve Transfer Application T-10837. The draft Preliminary Determination set forth a deadline of September 21, 2009, for the applicant to respond. The applicant requested that the Department proceed with issuance of a Preliminary Determination and provided the necessary information to demonstrate that the applicant is authorized to pursue the transfer
- 8. On September 8, 2009, the Department mailed a copy of the Preliminary Determination to the applicant proposing to approve Transfer Application T-10837. Additionally, the notice of the preliminary determination for the transfer application was published on the Department's weekly notice on September 15, 2009, and in the Baker City Herald

newspaper on September 25, and October 2 and 9, 2009, pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4020. No protests were filed in response to the notice.

Transfer Review Criteria (OAR 690-380-4010)

- 9. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the rights. There is no information in the record that would demonstrate that the rights are subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 10. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing rights were present within the five-year period prior to submittal of Transfer Application T-10837.
- 11. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the rights.
- 12. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The additional points of appropriation proposed in Transfer Application T-10837 are consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The additional points of appropriation proposed in application T-10837 are approved.
- 2. The right to the use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificates 53299, 74070 and any related decree.
- 3. Water right certificates 53299 and 74070 are cancelled.
- 4. The quantity of water diverted at the additional points of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of appropriation.
- 5. Water use measurement conditions:
 - a. Before water use may begin under this order, the water user shall install a totalizing flow meter, or, with prior approval of the Director, another suitable measuring device, at each point of diversion.
 - b. The water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order.
 - c. The water user shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices; provided however, where the meters or measuring devices are located within a private structure, the Watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

- 6. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original points of appropriation.
- 7. The approved changes shall be completed and full beneficial use of the water shall be made on or before **October 1, 2011**. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department within one year after the deadline for completion of the changes and full beneficial use of the water.
- 8. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, new certificates confirming the rights transferred will be issued.
