ORDER

Now at this time the above entitled matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer on the application of J. E. Reed and Ed Halvorson for the approval of a change in place of use of water under the Arnold Irrigation Company's canal and it appearing that by decree of the court for Deschutes County dated February 10, 1928, an inchoate water right was recognized in the name of the Arnold Irrigation Company for the irrigation of 9,392 acres, of which 35 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 21, Township 18 South, Range 12 East, W. M., is involved in this transfer;

That the applicant, J. E. Reed, owner of the above described tract, proposes to transfer 8 acres from said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 21, Township 18 South, Range 12 East, W. M., to 8 acres in Lots 1 and 2 and the E $\frac{1}{2}$  of Lots 3 and 4 of Block 3, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 4, Township 18 South, Range 12 East, W. M., owned by the applicant, Ed Halvorson. It appears that no existing rights would be affected by the approval of the transfer and that all lands involved herein are under the Arnold Irrigation Company's system, which company has submitted its approval in writing to the transfer;

Now, therefore, it is hereby ORDERED that the change in place of use be and the same is hereby approved without loss of the priority heretofore established, provided that such water to be transferred shall be applied to 8 acres within Lots 1 and 2 and the E $\frac{1}{2}$  of Lots 3 and 4, Block 3, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 4, Township 18 South, Range 12 East, W. M., within one year from the date of this order or within such period of time as may be extended by the State Engineer for good cause shown.
