**ORDER REJECTING TEMPORARY TRANSFER APPLICATION 9092**


Temporary Transfer Application 9092<sup>s</sup>, in the name of Harold A. Brown, was filed April 15, 2002. The applicant requested a temporary change in the place of use and additional point of appropriation for lands described by Permits G-9974 and G-10326.

ORS 540.523 allows any person who holds a "water use subject to transfer" to request to temporarily change the place of use. A "water use subject to transfer" is a water right established by 1) an adjudication under ORS chapter 539 as evidenced by court decree; 2) a water right certificate; 3) a water use permit for which a request for issuance of a water right certificate under ORS 537.250 has been received and approved by the Commission under ORS 537.250; or 4) a transfer application for which an order approving the change has been issued under ORS 540.530 and for which proper proof of completion of the change has been filed with the Commission.

Your application proposes the temporary change in place of use and additional point of appropriation of water for lands described by Permits G-9974 and G-10326. The final proof completed on Permits G-9974 and G-10326 does not define the extent the use of water was perfected within the terms of the permits. And because of this, proof to the satisfaction of the Director could not be made and therefore, the permit is not a "water use subject to transfer". The temporary transfer application should be rejected.

Temporary Transfer Application 9090, in the name of Harold A. Brown, is REJECTED and of no further force or effect. Any unearned fees will be refunded.
