Now at this time this matter coming on before the State Water Board for consideration, and it appearing that E. M. Meacham has made application for a transfer of water rights from 5 acres of land in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 21, T 15 S. R. 13 E. W. M., under the Pilot Butte Canal of the Central Oregon Irrigation District; that it is not practicable to economically use water for the irrigation of said land; that it is desired to transfer the water right appurtenant to said 5 acres, to 5 acres of land lying east of the said Pilot Butte Canal in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, T 15 S. R. 13 E. W. M.: NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED, that said application be and the same is hereby approved, and that whatever water right said E. M. Meacham or said District may have for said 5 acres of land in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 21, be and the same is hereby severed from said land, and is hereby transferred, and by this transfer becomes appurtenant, to 5 acres of land lying east of the Pilot Butte Canal in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, T 15 S. R. 13 E. W. M., without loss of priority of right heretofore established, except as to such existing rights to which such change is a detriment, and said right hereby transferred is hereby made subject and subsequent to any and all rights so injured by such change, to the extent of such injury.
