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On December 30, 1968, Lynn H. and Lorean Jackson submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of the following described land:

Beginning at a point on the easterly line of Lot 6, Riverdale Tracts, in the County of Jackson, said point being N. 14° 41' W. 720.7 feet from the southeast corner of said Lot; thence S. 75° 15' W. 78.4 feet; thence N. 14° 41' W. to the northerly line of said Lot 6; thence N. 64° 02! E. along said northerly line to the northeast corner of said Lot 6; thence S. 14° 41' E. along the easterly line of said Lot to the point of beginning;

Also beginning at a point on the easterly line of Lot 6, Riverdale Tracts, in the County of Jackson, said point being N. 14° 41' W. 720.7 feet from the southeast corner of said Lot; thence S. 75° 15' W. 78.4 feet; thence S. 14° 41' E. 75.0 feet; thence N. 75° 15' E. 78.4 feet; thence N. 14° 41' W. 15.0 feet to the point of beginning,

and the water right appurtenant thereto; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and request the same to be canceled.

The water right in question is for the use of not to exceed 0.002 cubic foot per second of the waters of Rogue River for irrigation of 0.17 acres in NW/4 NE/4, Section 21, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of August 25, 1911, and is evidenced by certificate of water right issued in the name of W. D. Hodgson and R. L. McBride and recorded at Page 1867, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the State Engineer that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the State Engineer shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the right for the use of not to exceed 0.002 cubic foot per second of the waters of Rogue River for irrigation of 0.17 acre in NWA NEWA, Section 21, Township 36 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of August 25, 1911, as evidenced by certificate of water right recorded at Page 1867, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
