ORDER AMENDING ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 3418

On June 1, 1976, Jackson County Political Subdivision filed an application in the office of the Water Resources Director for approval of a change in use heretofore made of water from Rogue River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The administrative order of the Water Resources Director, dated January 24, 1977, approving said application, entered at pages 271 to 273, Volume 28, Special Order Record, was in error at paragraph 8 on page 272 and at paragraph 1 on page 273, through omitting reference to a remaining right for the use of not to exceed 10.0 cubic feet per second of the waters of the Rogue River with a priority date of August 5, 1902, for operating fish ladders in S½ of Section 18, Township 36 South, Range 2 West, W.M., also described by the certificate issued to California-Oregon Power Company and recorded at page 15838, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that said paragraph 8 on page 272 be, and the same hereby is, amended to read: "The applicant herein has authoried cancellation of the balance of the right for power purposes, described by the certificate recorded at page 15838, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT involved in this proceeding"; and that said paragraph 1 on page 273 be, and the same hereby is, amended to read: "It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of water right heretofore issued to California-Oregon Power Company and recorded at page 15838, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a new certificate of water right shall be issued to Jackson County Political Subdivision to confirm the change in use heretofore made of water as authorized herein, and in addition thereto, to described the remaining right NOT involved

herein, for the use of not to exceed 10.0 cubic feet per second of the waters of Rogue River with a priority date of August 5, 1902, for operating fish ladders in S_2^{1} of Section 18, Township 36 South, Range 2 West, W.M.
