ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6813 submitted by

EDWIN L. AND JELLINDA DANIEL
15417 NORTH BANK ROAD
ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470.

The right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 43558, was perfected under Permit 12340 with a date of priority of AUGUST 31, 1936. The right allows the use of the NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 2.0 ACRES. This right is limited to 0.025 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized point of diversion: SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 15, T 26 S, R 4 W, WM, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 1.9 ACRES
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 0.1 ACRE
SECTION 15
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicants propose to change the point of diversion to:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 15, T 26 S, R 4 W, WM; 140 FEET SOUTH AND 1620 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 15.

The applicants also propose to change the place of use to:


SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 0.8 ACRE
SECTION 10
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 1.2 ACRES
SECTION 15
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

THESE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 1995.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.
3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right.

Certificate 43558 has been cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this and other transfers. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
