ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6459 submitted by

GERALD EDWARDS
93298 RIVER ROAD
JUNCTION CITY, OREGON 97448

to use the waters of A WELL in the WILLAMETTE RIVER BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATING 13.5 ACRES.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 30671, was perfected under Permit G-1599 with a date of priority of MAY 23, 1960. The right is limited to 0.16 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; LOT 7 (NW 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 9, T 16 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1170 FEET SOUTH AND 720 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by certificate 44846, was perfected under Permit G-560 with a date of priority of MAY 9, 1957. The right is limited to 0.006 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 9, T 16 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1636 FEET SOUTH AND 1175 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The new point of appropriation for both rights is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 9, T 16 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 1954 FEET SOUTH AND 377 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:


The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original points of appropriation.
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. The well at the new point of appropriation shall be constructed to the well construction standards in effect as of the date of this order and must include an access port.
5. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

Certificates 30671 and 44846 are hereby canceled. New certificates will be issued to confirm those portions of the rights NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, new certificates confirming these water rights will be issued.
