Management and Conservation Plan for the) WATER MANAGEMENT AND
Running Y Ranch Resort, Klamath County) CONSERVATION PLAN

Authority

OAR Chapter 690, Division 086, establishes the process and criteria for approving water management and conservation plans required under the conditions of permits, permit extensions and other orders of the Department.

Findings of Fact

1. The Running Y Ranch Resort submitted a Water Management and Conservation Plan (plan) to the Department on January 12, 2011. The plan was required by the Final Order approving Running Y Ranch Resort's previous plan.
2. The Department published notice of receipt of the plan on January 18, 2011, as required under OAR Chapter 690, Division 086. No comments were received.
3. The Department provided comments on the plan to Running Y Ranch Resort on April 12, 2011 and, in response, Running Y Ranch Resort submitted a final revised plan on May 10, 2011.
4. The Department reviewed the final revised plan and finds that it is generally consistent with the relevant requirements under OAR Chapter 690, Division 086.

Conclusion of Law

The Water Management and Conservation Plan submitted by Running Y Ranch Resort is consistent with the criteria in OAR Chapter 690, Division 086.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

1. The Running Y Ranch Resort Water Management and Conservation Plan is approved and shall remain in effect until May 11, 2021, unless this approval is rescinded pursuant to OAR 690-086-0920.

<p>This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.</p>

2. The Running Y Ranch Resort shall submit an updated plan meeting the requirements of OAR Chapter 690, Division 086 (effective November 1, 2002) within 10 years and no later than November 11, 2020.
3. The Running Y Ranch Resort shall submit a progress report containing the information required under OAR 690-086-0120(4) by May 11, 2016.
