Authority

ORS 540.530 and OAR 690-385-7600 describe the process for the Water Resources Department to issue or modify a water right certificate upon determination that an applicant has made satisfactory proof of the completion of the changes.

Findings of Fact

- 1. On February 2, 2012, the Department issued a final order, recorded in Special Order Volume 87, Pages 137-140, approving Transfer Application T-11338. The order established October 1, 2013, as the date for completion of the authorized changes in place of use.
- 2. An extension of time was requested and approved October 22, 2013. The order was recorded in Special Order Volume 91, pages 459-460. The order set an extended completion date of October 1, 2014.
- 3. Since the issuance of the order approving Transfer Application T-11338 there have been changes to the certificates involved in the transfer as further described below.
- 4. On September 24, 2013, Certificate 72283 was cancelled by Special Order Volume 91, Pages 331-359 approving Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-75. Certificates 88876 and 88878 were issued to supersede Certificate 72283. Certificate 88878 describes the portion of the right placed instream under CW-75, and Certificate 88876 describes that portion of the right reduced in rate under CW-75.
- 5. On April 10, 2015, Certificate 88876 was cancelled by Special Order Volume 95, Pages 520-534 approving Allocation of Conserved Water Application CW-81. Certificates 90176 and 90177 were issued to supersede Certificate 88876. Certificate 90176 describes the

portion of the right placed instream under CW-81, and Certificate 90177 describes that portion of the right reduced in rate under CW-81.

- 6. On January 2, 2015, the Department received a Claim of Beneficial Use (CBU) and associated maps from the applicant.
- 7. The Department reviewed the CBU and maps submitted by the applicant for Transfer Application T-11338.
- 8. The CBU did not contain a map of the point of diversion from the source. However, since the transfer involved the transfer of places of use only within an irrigation district and did not involve a change in the point of diversion, the existing maps on file with the Department are sufficient to identify the point of diversion from the source.
- 9. Satisfactory proof of the changes was submitted with evidence showing that water was used in the location and for the purpose as authorized by the final order approving Transfer Application T-11338.

Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to ORS 540.530 and OAR 690-385-7600, the Department may issue or modify a certificate upon a determination the application of water to beneficial use under the terms of the final order approving a permanent district transfer was completed to the extent authorized.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The water has been applied to beneficial use to the extent authorized under the terms of the final order approving Transfer Application T-11338.
- 2. Water right certificates 72279, 72281 and 90177 are modified. The Department shall issue water right certificates on a determination that it is necessary to produce certificates describing the water rights.
