ORDER APPROVING TRANSFER NO. 2806

On May 10, 1973, Lyle Tresham, filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in place of use of water from South Yamhill River, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate of water right issued to J. S. Tresham and recorded at page 33397, Volume 25, State Record of Water Right Certificates, confirms a right to the use of not to exceed 0.39 cubic feet per second of water from South Yamhill River for the irrigation of, among other lands, 6.5 acres in SWA NEW, and 3.5 acres in SEW NWW, Section 5, Township 5 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of May 15, 1939. These lands are irrigated from a point of diversion located 410 feet North and 440 feet East from the Easterly SE corner of Martin D.L.C. No. 37, being within the SEW NEW, Section 5, Township 5 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

The applicant herein, owner of the land above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom, without loss of priority to 8.4 acres in SE% SW%, 1.5 acres in SW% SE%, Section 5, and 0.1 acre in NW% NE%, Section 8, Township 5 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

Notice by publication as provided by ORS 540.520 was not given in connection with this application for the reason that said section provides notice is not required on an application for a change in place of use of water.

Mr. Clayton J. Gardner, Watermaster of District No. 1, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights.

Loyd Tresham, mortgage holder of the land involved, has submitted written approval of the changes in place of use of water.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the change in place of use of water is approved and the water right hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 6.5 acres in SW% NE%, and 3.5 acres in SE% NW%, Section 5, Township 5 South, Range 4 West, W.M., with a date of priority of May 15, 1939, be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 8.4 acres in SE% SW%, 1.5 acres in SW% SE%, Section 5 and 0.1 acre in NW% NE%, Section 8, Township 5 South, Range 4 West, W.M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1973.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to J. S. Tresham and recorded at page 33397, Volume 25,
State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled, and in lieu
thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the lands
not involved in this proceeding, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory
to the State Engineer of application of water to beneficial use, a
certificate of water right shall be issued to Lyle Tresham confirming
the extent to which the water has been applied beneficially.
