ORDER


On March 16, 1977, Gordon Chapman, Mayor of the City of Pilot Rock submitted an affidavit that the City of Pilot Rock is the owner of a water right and the lands to which the right is appurtenant; that the City of Pilot Rock has abandoned any and all interest in and to said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right evidenced by certificate issued to H.H. Gilbert and recorded at Page 2530, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, and is for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.09 cubic foot per second of water from Birch Creek, with a date of priority of 1905, for the irrigation of 4.0 acres in SW $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$ and 3.0 acres in SE $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 4, Township 1 South, Range 32 East W.M.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancelation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right evidenced by certificate recorded at Page 2530, Volume 3, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
