TRANSFER B-198


On May 15, 1969, Howard L. Brownson filed an application in the office of the State Engineer for the approval of a change in point of diversion of water from South Myrtle Creek, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The order of the State Engineer entered August 31, 1970 at page 50, Volume ^{20^{54a}} 70, Special Order Record, allowed a change in point of diversion from South Myrtle Creek for a portion of the lands described by the certificate issued to Howard L. Brownson and recorded at page 20541, Volume 15, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

Said new point of diversion was intended to be an additional point of diversion.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that said Order be amended to allow the original point of diversion (Point of Diversion 1) located 1,400 feet North and 3,200 feet West, and Point of Diversion 3, located 1,280 feet North and 2,020 feet West, both from the East Quarter Corner of Section 21, Township 29 South, Range 4 West, WM; Point of Diversion 1 being within NE 1/4 NW 1/4 and Point of Diversion 3 being within SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 21, both as projected within H. Weaver DLC 39.
