APPROVAL OF A CHANGE IN PLACE OF)
USE OF WATER)

On March 25, 1987, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Rose Marie Bussard, Personal Representative of the Estate of Theodore Edleman for approval of a change in place of use of water from Umatilla River under an existing right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

By a Supplemental Decree of the Circuit Court for Umatilla County, entered September 1, 1961, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Umatilla River and Its Tributaries, a water right was tabulated at page 435, Volume 15, in the name of Stanfield Irrigation District, for irrigation of, among other lands, a certain 0.51 acre in SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 32, Township 4 North, Range 29 East, WM, with a date of priority of March 8, 1905.

These lands also have a supplemental right under Permit 7400 to the use of water stored in McKay Reservoir with a date of priority of July 1, 1924.

The applicant herein, owner of the lands above described, proposes to transfer the water right therefrom to a certain 0.51 acre in SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 8, Township 4 North, Range 29 East, WM (Minardi).

The lands involved herein are within the boundaries of the Stanfield Irrigation District and the Board of Directors of said District approved the proposed change in place of use of water at a regular meeting.

Michael F. Ladd, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use of water may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use is approved, without loss of priority.

The approval of this transfer application does not confirm the status of the right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the subject water right is hereby severed from the place of use described in paragraph 2 above and shall be beneficially used as authorized by this order on or before October 1, 1988.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of complete application of water to beneficial use on the lands to which the water is transferred hereby, the change in place of use shall be considered perfected, and at a later date a certificate of water right shall be issued to Stanfield Irrigation District confirming this and other changes within the District, at the time certificates are issued confirming rights allowed in the Umatilla River Adjudication proceedings.
