O R D E R

On April 26, 1961, notice was given by certified mail pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.631 to 540.650 to the Milton-Freewater Labor Camp, c/o Mr. P. D. Goldberg, 311 N. Elizabeth, Milton-Freewater, Oregon, owners and occupants of the land to which a water right hereinafter described is appurtenant, of the State Engineer's intention to cancel said right.

The water right in question was established in the name of the Estate of Adeline Nelson by Decree of the Circuit Court for Umatilla County, entered May 16, 1932, In the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Walla Walla River and its Tributaries, for the use of the waters of Little Walla Walla River for the irrigation of 5.0 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 1, Township 5 North, Range 35 East, W. M., with a date of priority of 1868, said water right having been confirmed by certificate issued to said Estate of Adeline Nelson, and recorded at page 13095, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

No protest having been filed against the proposed cancelation of the water right within the sixty day period immediately following the notice, the water right should be canceled.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ORDERED that said water right be and the same hereby is canceled.
