O R D E R

Now at this time the above entitled matter coming on for consideration by the State Engineer and it appearing that by decree of the court for Wallowa County dated January 20th, 1919, a water right was recognized in the name of the Big Bend Water Ditch Company for the irrigation of 3,197.5 acres, with a date of priority of July 1, 1902, of which 12 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 21.5 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, Township 2 South, Range 45 E., W. M., are owned by K. S. Francis. The above described lands also have a supplemental supply under Certificate of Water Right No. 9311, confirming an appropriation for storage from Wallowa River under permits Nos. R347 and 2696, with a date of priority of January 9, 1915; and

That the applicant herein proposes to transfer 12 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 13 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 4, Township 2 South, Range 45 E., W. M. to a 25-acre tract in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, Township 2 South, Range 45 E., W. M.; and

That the Big Bend Ditch Company, through its president, G. W. Franklin, has submitted its approval in writing to the transfer and it appearing that the proposed transfer would inure to the benefit of the applicant in the production of crops and that such transfer will not be an injury to existing rights,

Now, therefore, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said change in place of use of water be and the same is hereby approved without loss of priority of the rights heretofore established, and shall be appurtenant to 25 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, Township 2 South, Range 45 E., W. M.; provided that said

water to be transferred shall be applied to said lands within one year from the date of this order, or such time as may be extended by the State Engineer for good cause shown.
