The above described lands also have a supplemental supply under Certificate of Water Right No. 9311, confirming an appropriation for storage from Wallowa River under permits Nos. R347 and 2696, with a date of priority of January 9, 1915; and

That the applicant herein proposes to transfer 12 acres in the NEANWA and 13 acres in the NWANWA Section 4, Township 2 South, Range 45 E., W. M. to a 25-acre tract in the SE1NW1 of Section 4, Township 2 South, Range 45 E., W. M.: and
