On October 14, 1980, Leonard Lundgren submitted an affidavit that he is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that he has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and requests the same be canceled.

The water right in question was established by Decree of Circuit Court for Deschutes County, entered May 1, 1911, in the Matter of the Determination of the Relative Rights to the Use of the Waters of Squaw Creek, tabulated at page 122, Volume 1, Order record of the Water Resources Director, in the name of P.B. Davis and F.M. Baldwin, and is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 12306, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of S.S. Johnson Company, and is for the use of not to exceed 0.458 cubic foot per second of water from Squaw Creek, with a date of priority of 1885, for irrigation of a certain 22.95 acres in SW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 4, Township 15 South, Range 10 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 12306, Volume 11, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.
