IN THE MATTER OF CANCELLATION OF A PORTION OF A WATER RIGHT IN THE NAME OF THEODORE C. NEWARD)))	ORDER

On March 22, 1984, Theodore C. Neward and Ruth I. Neward submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be canceled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 47340, Volume 40, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Theodore C. Neward, and is for the storage of not to exceed 20.0 acre-feet of water from Rock Creek, with a date of priority of May 28, 1974, for recreation in a reservoir located within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SW 1/4 NE 1/4, NE 1/4 NW 1/4 and SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 14, Township 2 North, Range 4 West, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Director that the water right has been abandoned by him and that he desires cancellation thereof, the Water Resources Director shall enter an order canceling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 47340, Volume 40, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is canceled, and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right NOT involved in this proceeding.
