AUTHORITY

ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580 establish the process in which a water right holder may submit a request to temporarily transfer the place of use and, if necessary to convey the water to the temporary place of use, the point of diversion or appropriation authorized under an existing water right. OAR Chapter 690, Division 380 implements the statutes and provides the Department's procedures and criteria for evaluating transfer applications.


On June 21, 2004, Carl Jensen filed an application to temporarily transfer the place of use under Certificate 48177. The Department assigned the application number T-9751.

Notice of the application for temporary transfer was published pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.

On November 16, 2004, Carl Jensen submitted a written request to withdraw transfer application T-9751. Transfer Application T-9751, in the name of Carl Jensen, is withdrawn and of no further force of effect. Any unearned fees will be refunded.
