O R D E R

The city of Medford is the holder of permit No. 23210 to appropriate 100 cubic feet per second of water from the Rogue River for municipal use.

The city has advised the State Engineer that the appropriation described in this permit has not been made, but it is its desire to preserve the right for this development. It is anticipated that the present supply from Big Butte Springs will be sufficient to meet water requirements for the present time. However, the additional supply allowed under this permit is of vital importance for the future.

It is believed that it will be consistent with the public interest to grant the extension applied for.

IT IS THEREFORE HEREBY ORDERED that the time limits be extended to October 1, 1965 in which to begin construction and to October 1, 1970 in which to complete construction and make complete application of water to beneficial use.
