On April 23, 1984, an affidavit was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by W.M. Williams, Eliabeth A. Williams, Henry C. Williams and Laguita H. Williams for approval of a change from primary to supplemental use of water from a well.

The certificate recorded at page 30074, Volume 22, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name George D. Weaver, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.044 cubic foot per second from a well, for irrigation of 2.2 acres in SE 1/4 SW 1/4 and 3.6 acres in SW 1/4 SE 1/4, both as projected within T. Whitted DLC 44, Section 32, Township 29 South, Range 5 West, WM, with a date of priority of November 24, 1958.

The authorized point of appropriation is located North 88 degrees 17 minutes, 20 seconds West, 2355.6 feet from the Southwest Corner of Adams DLC 42, being within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 32, Township 29 South, Range 5 West, WM.

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to change the right from primary irrigation to supplemental irrigation on the same lands.

No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed diminution of water right may be made without injury to existing rights, the petition should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change from primary irrigation to supplemental irrigation is approved, without loss of priority.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 30074, Volume 22, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and a certificate of water right be issued to the applicant herein designating said water right as supplemental on the aforesaid lands.
