IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF C. F. WILLIAMSON AND DESCHUTES COUNTY FOR APPROVAL OF A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE OF WATER WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE ARNOLD IRRIGATION DISTRICT.

## ORDER APPROVING APPLICATION

On June 9, 1938, C. F. Williamson and Deschutes County filed an application for approval of a change in place of use of water from Deschutes River within the boundaries of the Arnold Irrigation District.

In the adjudication proceedings involving the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of Deschutes River and its tributaries, a water right was recognized in the name of the Arnold Irrigation Company for the irrigation of, among other lands, 30 acres in the SW1 SE1, 38 acres in the SE1 SE1, and 34 acres in the NE1 SE1, Section 9, Township 18 South, Range 13 East, W. M.

The applicants herein propose to transfer the water rights appurtenant to 30 acres in the SW<sub>1</sub> SE<sub>2</sub>, 38 acres in the SE<sub>2</sub> SE<sub>4</sub>, and 2 acres in the NE<sub>2</sub> SE<sub>2</sub>, said Section 9, to 35 acres in the NW<sub>2</sub> SW<sub>3</sub>, 20 acres in the NE<sub>2</sub> SW<sub>3</sub>, and 15 acres in the NW<sub>2</sub> SE<sub>3</sub>, Section 24, Township 18 South, Range 11 East, V. M.

The Arnold Irrigation District, as successor-in-interest to the Arnold Irrigation Company, having submitted its approval of the proposed transfer, it appears that such change in place of use of water can be made without injury to existing rights.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the proposed change in place of use of water be and the same hereby is approved and the water rights hereinbefore described as appurtenant to 30 acres in the SWE SEE, 38 acres in

the SE<sub>2</sub> SE<sub>4</sub>, and 2 acres in the NE<sub>4</sub> SE<sub>4</sub>, Section 9, Township 18 South, Range 13 East, W. M., be severed therefrom and simultaneously and without loss of priority transferred to 35 acres in the NE<sub>4</sub> SW<sub>4</sub>, 20 acres in the NE<sub>4</sub> SW<sub>4</sub>, and 15 acres in the NE<sub>4</sub> SE<sub>4</sub>, Section 24, Township 18 South, Range 11 East, W. M.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use within the time fixed for completion of inchoate water rights in the matter of the determination of the relative rights to the use of the waters of Deschutes River and its tributaries.
