Transfer Application 4942, in the name of John P. Jarnagin, proposed a change in point of diversion of water from East Fork Illinois River under a certain right with a priority date of 1857, for irrigation of a certain 1.2 acres in SW 1/4 NE 1/4 and 4.5 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 11, Township 40 South, Range 8 West, WM.

The order of the Water Resources Director, entered January 22, 1982, approving Transfer Application 4942, provided: "...that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1983."

The applicant has failed to make proof to the satisfaction of the Water Resources Director that the proposed change was accomplished within the provisions of the order, therefore, the subject water right has been lost.

Further, the applicant has submitted a statement that the water right so transferred has not been used, and has authorized cancellation of the right.
