OF NORTH UNIT IRRIGATION DISTRICT )

On March 29, 1989, Cheri Bashor, District Ranger for the U.S. Forest Service, Crooked River National Grassland, submitted an affidavit that the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Forest Service is the owner of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that the Forest Service has abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be cancelled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 51233, Volume 46, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of North Unit Irrigation District. It is for the use of not to exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second of water from Crooked River, with a date of priority of September 18, 1968, for the irrigation of 3.1 acres, NW 1/4 SW 1/4, Section 32, Township 13 South, Range 13 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the commission shall enter an order cancelling the water right."

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the said water right described by the certificate recorded at page 51233, Volume 46, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is cancelled.
