ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6502 submitted by

ZX RANCH

PAISLEY, OREGON 97636

to use the waters of A WELL in the SILVER LAKE BASIN for IRRIGATING 20.2 ACRES.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by Certificate 50759, was perfected under Permit G-8988 with a date of priority of JUNE 3, 1980. The right is limited to 0.25 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 21, T 27 S, R 19 E, W.M.; WELL 14 - 930 FEET NORTH AND 1570 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 21, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The new point of appropriation is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 13, T 28 S, R 15 E, W.M.; WELL 19 - 15 FEET SOUTH AND 1320 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the new place of use is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 20.2 ACRES
SECTION 13
TOWNSHIP 28 SOUTH, RANGE 15 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well 19) shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation (well 14).
3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
4. The well at the new point of appropriation shall be constructed to the well construction standards in effect as of the date of this order and must include an access port.
5. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
6. The following former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this water right:



SE 1/4 SW 1/4 3.4 ACRES
NE 1/4 SE 1/4 4.2 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 2.9 ACRES
SE 1/4 SE 1/4 1.7 ACRES
SECTION 21

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.6 ACRES
NW 1/4 NE 1/4 3.7 ACRES
NE 1/4 NW 1/4 0.6 ACRE
SECTION 28

TOWNSHIP 27 SOUTH, RANGE 19 EAST, W.M.

Certificate 50759 is hereby cancelled. A new certificate will be issued to confirm that portion of the right NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
