ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE

AND ADDITIONAL POINTS OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6833 submitted by

DOUBLE M RANCH, INC. P.O. BOX 398 ECHO, OREGON 97826.

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 41756, was perfected under Permit G-3971 with a date of priority of FEBRUARY 1, 1968. The right allows the use of a SUMP WELL, a tributary of the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 65.3 ACRES. The right is limited to 0.82 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; NW\(\frac{1}{2}\) NE\(\frac{1}{2}\), SECTION 13, T 3 N, R 28 E, WM; 270 FEET SOUTH AND 2540 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 13, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by Certificate 65880, was perfected under Permit G-10222 with a date of priority of JANUARY 10, 1983. The right allows the use of a PIT WELL, a tributary of the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN, for IRRIGATION OF 49.8 ACRES. The right is limited to 0.62 cubic foot per second, if available at the original well; SW\(\frac{1}{2}\) NW\(\frac{1}{2}\), SECTION 18, T 3 N, R 29 E, WM; 1450 FEET SOUTH AND 3160 FEET WEST FROM THE N\(\frac{1}{2}\) CORNER, SECTION 18, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation under these rights is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

The authorized place of use is as follows:

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The applicant proposes to change the points of appropriation for both water rights to:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 13, T 3 N, R 28 E, WM; 270 FEET SOUTH AND 2540 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 13; and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 18, T 3 N, R 29 E, WM; 1450 FEET SOUTH AND 3160 FEET WEST FROM THE N $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 18.

THESE CHANGES TO EXISTING WATER RIGHTS MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1996.
- 2. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (well), together with the quantity of water diverted at the old points of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original points of appropriation.
- 3. The water user shall install in-line flow meters or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. The water user shall install and maintain valves or other means to insure water from the proper source is applied to the proper land. They types and plans of the valves of the valves or other means must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construct and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 5. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original points of appropriation.
- 6. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this water right.

Certificates 41756 and 65880 are cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
