O R D E R

On April 12, 1967, M. C. and Pearl Helm submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of lands claimed to have been irrigated as described in a certificate of registration; that they have abandoned said claim of water right and request the same be canceled.

That part of the claimed right in question is for the use of not to exceed 250 gallons per minute from a well located north 88 degrees east 17.5 chains from the southwest corner of Section 17, Township 10 South, Range 2 West, W.M., with a beginning date of 1946, for irrigation of the following lands:

23.7 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
0.9 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
0.2 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
4.5 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 17

Township 10 South, Range 2 West, W.M.,

and is described in the certificate of registration recorded in Volume 5, page 1000, Ground Water Registration Records.

That part of the claimed right to the use of not to exceed 100 gallons per minute from the described well for irrigation of 12.8 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 0.6 acre in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 17, Township 10 South, Range 2 West, W.M., and recorded in said certificate, is not in question.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the claim of water right for the use of not to exceed 250 gallons per minute from a well located north 88 degrees east 17.5 chains from the southwest corner of Section 17, Township 10


South, Range 2 West, W.M., with a beginning date of 1946, for irrigation
of the following lands:

23.7 acres SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
0.9 acre NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
0.2 acre NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
4.5 acres SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
