ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE AND POINT OF APPROPRIATION

Pursuant to ORS 537.705, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves TRANSFER 6503 submitted by

ZX RANCH

PAISLEY, OREGON 97636

to use the waters of 6 WELLS in the SILVER LAKE AND FORT ROCK BASINS for PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 457.25 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 263.35 ACRES.

The right to be transferred, as evidenced by Certificate 50754, was perfected under Permit G-6670 with a date of priority of SEPTEMBER 23, 1974. The right is limited to 9.00 cubic feet per second being; 2.57 cfs from wells 2 and 3, 1.625 cfs from well 4, 1.625 cfs from well 5, 1.62 cfs from well 6 and 1.56 cfs from well 7, if available at the original wells (14, 15, 16 & 17), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The new point of appropriations are located as follows:

WELL 2 - NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 26, T 28 S, R 14 E, W.M.; 680 FEET SOUTH AND 70 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 26.

WELL 3 - NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 25, T 28 S, R 14 E, W.M.; 680 FEET SOUTH AND 70 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 25.

WELL 4 - NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 29, T 26 S, R 15 E, W.M.; 1320 FEET SOUTH AND 1320 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 29.

WELL 5 - SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 29, T 26 S, R 15 E, W.M.; 1320 FEET NORTH AND 1320 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 29.

WELL 6 - SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 30, T 28 S, R 15 E, W.M.; 320 FEET NORTH AND 1320 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 30.

WELL 7 - SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 28, T 26 S, R 15 E, W.M.; 1320 FEET NORTH AND 1320 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed changes shall be completed on or before October 1, 1992.
- The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (wells 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 & 7) shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original points of appropriation (wells 14, 15, 16 & 17).
- 3. When required by the Department the water user shall install an inline flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 4. The well at the new point of appropriation shall be constructed to the well construction standards in effect as of the date of this order and must include an access port.
- 5. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.
- 6. The following former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as part of this water right:
