ORDER APPROVING  
TRANSFER 4868

On August 12, 1981, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Lawrence and Marjorie Iverson for approval of a change in place of use of water from ground water, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 537.705.

The certificate recorded at page 46575, Volume 39, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Lawrence and Marjorie Iverson, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.109 cubic foot per second from ground water for irrigation of 8.7 acres in SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 18, Township 28 South, Range 15 East, WM, with a date of priority of March 26, 1973.

The authorized point of appropriation is located 1,040 feet South and 1,250 feet West from the Northeast Corner of Section 19, being within the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 19, Township 28 South, Range 15 East, WM (Marjorie Iverson Well).

The applicants herein, owners of the lands above described, propose to sever the right therefrom and, without loss of priority, to irrigate in lieu thereof 8.7 acres in NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 20, Township 28 South, Range 15 East, WM.

Dennis R. Glender, Watermaster, has filed a statement to the effect that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights.


No objections having been filed and it appearing that the proposed change in place of use may be made without injury to existing rights, the application should be approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the requested change in place of use, as described herein, without loss of priority, is approved.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that said water so transferred shall be applied to beneficial use on or before October 1, 1983.

It is FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate recorded at page 46575, Volume 39, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is canceled; and in lieu thereof a new certificate be issued covering the balance of the right NOT involved in this proceeding; and upon proof satisfactory to the Water Resources Director of completion of works and beneficial use of water to the extent intended under the provisions of this order, a confirming certificate of water right shall be issued to the applicants herein.
