ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN CHARACTER OF USE AND PLACE OF USE

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6607 submitted by

GRANT COUNTY ROAD DEPARTMENT P.O. BOX 190 CANYON CITY, OREGON 97820.

The right to be modified was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for GRANT County as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 25121. The decree is recorded in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1866.

The right allows the use of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 0.3 ACRE. This right is limited to 1/40th CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND PER ACRE IRRIGATED FROM APRIL 1 TO SEPTEMBER 30; FURTHER LIMITED TO ONE ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE PER CALENDAR MONTH TO JULY 1 AND 3/4 ACRE-FOOT PER ACRE THEREAFTER; TOTAL FIVE ACRE-FEET PER ACRE, if available at the authorized point of diversion: LUCE DITCH, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The authorized place of use is located as follows:

NE¼ NW¼ 0.3 ACRE SECTION 29 TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.

The applicant proposes to change the character of use to filling of tank trucks for ROAD SPRINKLING, including construction and dust abatement.

The applicant also proposes to change the place of use to the fill site located as follows:

SW¼ SE¼
SECTION 21
TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.

THESE CHANGES TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

- 1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 1996.
- When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 3. The former place of use shall no longer be irrigated as a part of this water right.
- 4. This right shall be limited to a rate of 0.008 cubic foot per second of water. The right shall be further limited to 0.3 acrefoot per calendar month to July 1, and 0.225 acre-foot per calendar month thereafter, for a total of 1.5 acre-feet of water during the season from April 1 to September 30, of each year.

Certificate 25121 is cancelled. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming this water right will be issued.
