Haynes and recorded at page 17014, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates are canceled, and upon receipt of proof satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized change in use, place of use and point of diversion, certificates of water right shall be issued to City of Ashland confirming said changes in use, place of use and point of diversion."

There are errors in showing the certificates issued in evidence of the right in question as recorded at pages 17013 and 17014, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates, instead of recorded at pages 16013 and 16014, Volume 13, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

NOW, THEREFORE, it hereby is ORDERED that the part of the order of the State Engineer entered August 16, 1966, above set forth be deleted therefrom and insert in lieu thereof the following, to-wit:

"It is FURTHER ORDERED that certificate of water right heretofore issued to Henry Haynes and recorded at page 16013 and the certificate

issued to J. R. G. Haynes and recorded at page 16014, Volume 13, State
Record of Water Right Certificates are canceled, and upon receipt of proof
satisfactory to the State Engineer of completion of the authorized change in
use, place of use and point of diversion, certificates of water right shall
be issued to City of Ashland confirming said changes in use, place of use
and point of diversion."
