ORDER APPROVING A CHANGE IN POINTS OF DIVERSION

Pursuant to ORS 540.510 to 540.530, after notice was given and no objections were filed, and finding that no injury to existing water rights would result, this order approves, as conditioned or limited herein, TRANSFER 6456 submitted by

GREEN VILLA FARMS
P.O. BOX 37
INDEPENDENCE, OREGON 97351.

The first right to be modified, as evidenced by a PORTION of Certificate 50398, was perfected under Permit 15237 with a date of priority of APRIL 6, 1942. The right allows the use of WILLAMETTE RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 140.5 ACRES. This right is limited to 1.76 cubic foot per second, if available at the authorized points of diversion: LOT 6 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), LOT 5 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), SECTION 36, T 7 S, R 4 W, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The second right to be modified, as evidenced by certificate 36795, was perfected under Permit 29117 with a date of priority of SEPTEMBER 23, 1963. The right allows the use of WILLAMETTE RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 249.7 ACRES. This right is limited to 3.12 cubic feet per second, if available at the authorized points of diversion: LOT 3 (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$); LOT 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$); SECTION 1, LOT 1 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), SECTION 12, T 8 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 3470 FEET NORTH AND 6620 FEET EAST, 1130 FEET NORTH AND 5790 FEET EAST, 60 FEET SOUTH AND 5480 FEET EAST, ALL FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

LOT 3 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), LOT 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), SECTION 1, T 8 S, R 4 W, W.M.;
(1942 and 1963) - 4940 FEET SOUTH AND 1080 FEET EAST, (1963) - 7240 FEET
SOUTH AND 450 FEET EAST, FROM THE WEST $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER OF SECTION 36.


The right to use the water for the above purpose is restricted to
beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

THIS CHANGE TO AN EXISTING WATER RIGHT MAY BE MADE PROVIDED THE
FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET BY THE WATER USER:

1. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1,
1993.
2. The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion,
shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original
points of diversion.
3. When required by the Department, the water user shall install and
maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable
device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.
The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be
approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and
shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Certificates 36795 and 50398 are cancelled. A new certificate will be
issued to confirm that portion of the right, evidenced by certificate
50398, NOT involved in this transfer. When satisfactory proof of the
completed change is received, new certificates confirming these water
rights will be issued.
