Findings of Fact

- 1. The City of Klamath Falls filed an application to transfer the point of appropriation under Certificate 32193. The Department assigned the application number T-6852.
- 2. Certificate 32193 was cancelled by Transfer 6214, and is superseded by Certificate 80655.

4. Application T-6852 proposes to move the authorized point of appropriation approximately 200 feet southeast to:

- 5. Notice of the application for transfer was published pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 6. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right, and no evidence is available that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.

- 7. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right is present.
- 8. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 9. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The change in point of appropriation proposed in application T-6852 appears to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580, and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

The change in point of appropriation proposed in T-6852 is approved, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The right to use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 80655 and any related decree.
- 2. Certificate 80655 is cancelled; Certificate 80755 shall be issued to describe the remaining rights NOT involved in this transfer.
- 3. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 2009.
- 4. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department by October 1, 2010.
- 5. Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer (water source) as the original point of appropriation.
- 6. The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation, together with that diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of appropriation.
- 7. Prior to diverting water at the new point of appropriation, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water appropriated. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.
- 8. When satisfactory proof of the completed change is received, a new certificate confirming the transferred water rights shall be issued.
