Findings of Fact

James Cowan filed an application to change the place of use and character of use under Certificate 79171. The Department assigned the application number T-9418.

2. James W. and Nancy L. Cowan are the landowners. Martha O. Pagel is the agent authorized to act on behalf of the applicant.

3. The portion of the right to be transferred is as follows:

- 4. Application T-9418 proposes to change the character of use to storage (pond maintenance) for recreation, aesthetics, and fish and wildlife purposes.
- 5. Application T-9418 proposes to change the place of use of the right to:

- 6. Notice of the application for transfer was published pursuant to ORS 540.520 and OAR 690-380-4000. No comments were filed in response to the notice.
- 7. Water has been used within the last five years according to the terms and conditions of the right, and no evidence is available that would demonstrate that the right is subject to forfeiture under ORS 540.610.
- 8. A pump, pipeline, and sprinkler system sufficient to use the full amount of water allowed under the existing right is present.
- 9. The proposed change would not result in enlargement of the right.
- 10. The proposed change would not result in injury to other water rights.

Conclusions of Law

The changes in place of use and character of use proposed in application T-9418 appear to be consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.705 and 540.505 to 540.580, and OAR 690-380-5000.

Now, therefore, it is ORDERED:

- 1. The changes proposed in T-9418 are approved, subject to the following conditions.
- 2. Certificate 79171 is cancelled; Certificate 80667 shall be issued to describe the remaining right.

- 3. The right to use of the water is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in Certificate 79171 and any related decree.
- 4. The proposed change shall be completed on or before October 1, 2005.
- 5. A Claim of Beneficial Use prepared by a Certified Water Rights Examiner shall be submitted by the applicant to the Department by October 1, 2006.
- 6. Upon proof to the satisfaction of the Director, a certificate shall be issued confirming the transferred water rights.
